

Essential Guidelines for Artwork Preparation

ARTWORK REGUIREMENTS

- Color format: CMYK only
- File format: PDF (Press quality, single page only)
- Minimum resolution: 150 ppi (at 1:1 scale)
- · Remove crops and all extra markings before saving file
- · Convert all fonts to outlines
- · All the images must be embedded, not linked

DESIGN REQUIREMENTS FOR LAYOUTS

- **Fabric Bleed:** Please allocate an extra 0.4 inches of fabric on all edges of your design. This surplus will be tucked into the construction's groove, ensuring a snug fit without visible edges.
- **Safety Distance:** Ensure all key design elements or text are at least 4 inches away from the final print's edge. This ensures that essential content isn't positioned too close to the area where the fabric is tucked into the groove.

OPTIMIZED BLACK INTENSITY: CMYK SETUP GUIDE FOR SUPERIOR PRINTS

Through ongoing refinement, the criteria for achieving intense black in prints may vary over time. At this juncture, please adhere to the following specifications for preparing your print-ready file:

C:75 M:75 Y:75 K:100
